Admin will contact Taylor Wimpey to get them to cut the second piece of land opposite the Ram. A quote has been received from Tivoli for the installation only of 2 x parking posts, and 2 x bollards around the Community Centre carpark. Admin shared quotes for parking posts and bollards .SA proposed parking posts 2 x parking posts at £52.02 each, 2 x bollards at £24.00 each, and Tivoli to install them, seconded by HJ, carried. Admin is to request a quote from Tivoli to level and re-soil graves in the civilian cemetery, once plots are identified.
